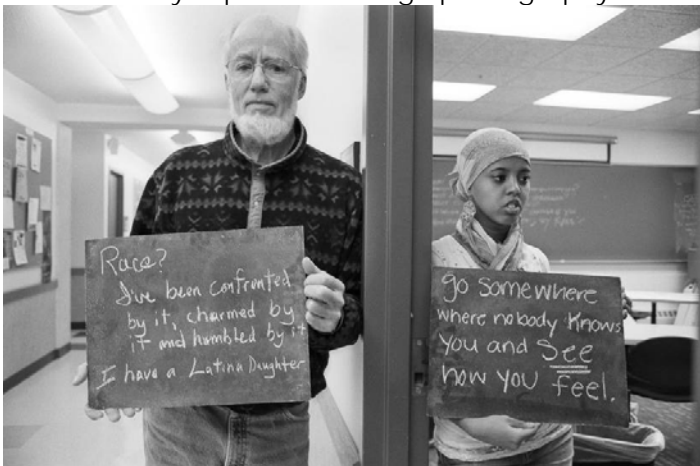

### Writing/Essay/Journal

What emotions can be most easily expressed through photography?
